We were able to serve a meal from this year's wonderful crop of locally grown foods and to leave people with information about "food sovereignty." It could not have been done without your time commitment.

Farm/ Art D-Tour. One of our goals is to connect people with the land that sustains them. If you are looking for a way to enjoy the fall color and also to learn more about the world of agriculture in the surrounding area, consider the self-guided Farm/Art D-Tour available from Oct. 7-16. This is a 50-mile tour through scenic working lands of Sauk County punctuated by farm-based art installations and artist-built mobile Roadside Culture Stands selling fresh, locally grown produce. You'll also find notes about some of the fields at the sites.
